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JJDPC Commission:

The Juvenile Justice/Delinquency Prevention Commission of Riverside County is a state-mandated, court-appointed authority. The general purpose of the Commission is to inquire into the administration of the juvenile court law in this county, to ensure that the rights or physical, mental, or moral welfare of children are not violated or threatened by their present circumstances or environment. The Commission is dedicated to the promotion of an effective juvenile justice system operated in an environment of credibility, dignity, fairness, and respect for the youth, their families, and their communities.

Section 225 of the Welfare and Institutions Code requires each county to have a Juvenile Justice Commission.

The Commission's responsibilities include:

- Annual inspections of juvenile facilities including detention facilities and group homes used for the confinement and/or placement of any minor in Riverside County.
- Conducting public or closed hearings on matters relating to juvenile law in the County; and Advocating for youth and needed services for youth in the justice system.
