

## Summoning Law Enforcement

### 1043.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for summoning law enforcement. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

### 1043.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Executive Committee;
- Juvenile Facility Services Policy; Escapes/AWOLS;
- Welfare and Institutions Code § 871.

### 1043.3 POLICY

It is the responsibility of the duty officer (DO)/supervising probation officer (SPO) or the facility manager(s) to contact law enforcement and request assistance as necessary.

### 1043.4 SUMMONING LAW ENFORCEMENT

The decision to contact law enforcement shall be made by the facility manager(s) or the DO/SPO. Whenever the DO/SPO authorizes the summoning of law enforcement, they shall notify the facility manager immediately or as soon as it is safe to do so.

#### 1043.4.1 EMERGENCY/NON-EMERGENCY CONTACT

In emergencies, law enforcement officers shall be notified immediately by the control center staff, by calling (9) 911. In non-emergencies, the appropriate agency shall be contacted by dialing the business number after the facility manager(s) or designee is contacted and approves such notification.
