

## Applicability of Standards

### 900.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for standards in juvenile facilities. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

#### 900.1.1 DEFINITION

Definition related to this policy includes:

**Special Purpose Juvenile Facility** - A county facility used for temporary confinement of a youth, not to exceed 96 hours, prior to transfer to a full service juvenile facility or release.

### 900.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Board of State and Community Corrections Title 15 § 1310;
- Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 209, 210 & 885.

### 900.3 POLICY

The standards and requirements set forth by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) shall apply to any juvenile facility that is used for the confinement of youth.

### 900.4 JUVENILE FACILITIES

All juvenile facilities, with the exception of special purpose juvenile facilities, shall comply with all regulations.

### 900.5 SPECIAL PURPOSE JUVENILE FACILITIES

Special purpose juvenile facilities shall comply with all regulations except the following:

- (a) Youth Supervision Staff Orientation and Training;
- (b) Education Program;
- (c) Health Education;
- (d) Food Service Plan/Food Services Manager;
- (e) Special Clothing; and
- (f) Hair Care Services.
