

Juvenile Criminal History Information

902.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for the release of juvenile criminal history information to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC). This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

902.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Board of State and Community Corrections Title 15 § 1312;
- Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 204.5, 209, 210 & 885.

902.3 POLICY

Juvenile criminal history information necessary for conducting juvenile facility inspections, as specified in Section 209 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, shall be made available to the staff of the BSCC. Such information shall be held confidential except that published reports may contain information in a form which does not identify an individual.

902.4 ACCESS

The Chief Probation Officer or designee shall ensure that the BSCC has access to juvenile criminal history information for the purpose of conducting juvenile facility inspections.
