

# Control of Firearms, Other Weapons, Ammunition and Explosives

## 914.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for storing and disposing of firearms, other weapons, ammunition and explosives brought into juvenile facilities. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

## 914.3 POLICY

Firearms, other weapons, ammunition and explosives shall be strictly controlled and, except in emergency situations, shall not be permitted in juvenile facilities. Each facility manager shall ensure a sign is posted at the entrance of the juvenile facility specifying the conduct prohibited and the penalties under Section 871.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC).

## 914.4 FACILITY SECURITY

The duty officer (DO) and all juvenile facility staff are responsible to ensure firearms, other weapons (i.e. knives), ammunition and explosives of any type are not to be carried beyond the public entrance, given the threat they pose to safety and security.

## 914.6 NON-LAW ENFORCEMENT

Should a non-law enforcement visitor have a firearm, other weapon, ammunition or explosive in their possession, they shall be prohibited from entering the facility. [REDACTED]
