

Riot Control

919.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement facility-specific written policy and procedures in the event of a riot situation. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

919.1.1 DEFINITIONS

Definitions related to this policy include:

Riot - Any use of force or violence, disturbing the public peace, or any threat to use force or violence, if accompanied by immediate power of execution, by two or more persons acting together, and without authority of law. Refer to California Penal Code (PC) Section 404.

919.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

919.3 POLICY

Every reasonable precaution shall be taken to ensure the safety of all individuals and property in the event of a riot.

919.4 REQUIREMENTS

A written facility-specific procedure shall be available in each juvenile facility that specifies the action to be taken in a riot situation.

919.5 STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

If a riot situation is imminent or active, staff shall announce [REDACTED] and the location of the incident via the Handie-Talkie (HT) radio to summon the duty officer (DO) and all available staff.
