

Bomb Threats

922.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures in the event of a bomb threat. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

922.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Board of State and Community Corrections Title 15, Article 3, § 1327;
- Juvenile Facility Services Policy: Threatening Telephone Calls;
- Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 209, 210, & 885.

922.3 POLICY

Every reasonable precaution shall be taken to ensure the safety of individuals and property in the event of a bomb threat.

922.4 REQUIREMENTS

A written procedure shall be available in each juvenile facility that specifies the action to be taken in an emergency situation involving a bomb threat.

The facility manager(s) shall ensure all juvenile facility staff conduct an annual review of bomb threat procedures.

All juvenile facility staff shall be constantly on the alert for suspicious objects or persons located within or around the juvenile facility.
